PROGRAM

DESCRIPTION

It is becoming apparent that many parents, teachers, and community leaders possess insufficient knowledge and skills to handle persons with disabilities (PWDs). Consequently, there is a great tendency for many to discriminate PWDs. Indeed, PWDs are not included in many aspects of community life. Often, they are the last to be considered.

As of now, we find also the lack of public facilities that cater to the needs of PWDs. Interventions to be availed by parents are still very scarce, and if they are present, they are the last of the priorities of many parents and community leaders. Many teachers also fail to

some extent to acquire needed competencies in handling disability issues and concerns. Those who are interested in further specialization are hampered by insufficient funds.

We believe that this program will give opportunities to parents, teachers, and community leaders to acquire essential knowledge and skills to better understand persons with disabilities, and regard them as co-equals with rights and privileges due them.

Continuing educational activities for the parents, teachers, and community leaders have to be available. These will break the walls of misunderstanding PWDs. These will help communities become more inclusive. These will continuously liberate parents from their negative misconceptions of PWDs. Hence, a possible climate acceptance of PWDs shall be reinforced in the process.

Our proposed intervention to this problem then, as briefly mentioned above, will be continuing educational conferences for parents, teachers, and community leaders. By conducting conferences every month, we are confident that the perceived problem of inadequacy of knowledge and skills shall be solved.
